Outline	Call for application to an assistant professor position for Surface / Interface Chemistry Group in Division of Chemistry, Department of Materials Engineering Science, Graduate School of Engineering Science, Osaka University. The group call for a young researcher who can contribute to the research and education on the fields of interfacial chemistry, particularly for the microscopic mechanisms of transfer of electron or energy carrier and relating reaction processes at liquid / solid interfaces and the functions of the interfaces for energy conversion. The successful candidate will do research and teaching in the Division of Chemistry, Department of Materials Engineering Science in cooperation with Prof. Ken-ichi Fukui.
