Outline	The Graduate School of Engineering Science at Osaka University seeks to appoint a Professor in the Division of Bioengineering, Department of Mechanical Science and Bioengineering. The expected research focus is on i) the investigation of the structure and/or function of living systems/bodies, ii) technical development in biomedical engineering and/or biomimetic systems, and/or iii) interdisciplinary studies on the above fields with, for example, system optimization and control theories, which are all to be studied with mechanics-based approaches.
