Temporarily Departing Japan, and Re-entry

Dear All,

This is the Graduate Students Section, Graduate School of Engineering Science at Osaka University.

For those of you planning temporary travel to your respective home countries during your summer, winter, or spring breaks, here is an overview of what to expect upon re-entry to Japan. We hope that this will help you to navigate the procedures at the airport and beyond, many of which may change at any given moment.

Please remember to follow the procedures outlined below, which we have divided into four categories.

- 1. To Do Before You Depart Japan
- 2. What You Need to Do in Order to Re-enter Japan
- 3. MOFA Links
- 4. Additional Links That You May Find Useful

1. To Do Before You Depart Japan

- 1) Obtain your supervisor's permission to travel.
- 2) Confirm your home country's requirements for entry (PCR tests, etc.)
- 3) Make sure you know what you can expect upon re-entry to Japan.
- 4) Enter your travel information in the "Travel Abroad Registration System".

[The Re-entry Permit (on your Embarkation Card*1)]

For foreign nationals temporarily departing Japan with the intention of re-entering-

You will want to make sure that you obtain a re-entry permit (*sainyukokukyoka*/再入国許可) before departing Japan.

There are two types of re-entry permits. Those who intend to return to Japan within a year of departing must obtain a Special Re-Entry Permit.

*1 It can be found in the airport; if you are unable to locate one, the airport staff will help you) It is extremely important to remember that you will need to present both this re-entry permit and your residence card to Customs, otherwise you may be denied entry and subsequently deported.

Make sure that your residence card isn't set to expire while you are in your home country, before you return to Japan.

2. What You Need to Do in Order to Re-enter Japan * Refer MOFA Links for 1)-4)

Be prepared with the following documents/device:

- 1) Inspection certificate
- 2) Written pledge
- 3) Smartphone (if you do not have one, you will be required to rent one at the airport)
- 4) Questionnaire (provide contact information for subsequent follow-up)
- 5) Your residence card
- 6) Your Re-entry Permit (on your Embarkation Card)

[The Written Pledge]

- an agreement to abide by the quarantine rules, which are as follows:
- 1. To not use public transportation for 14 days after arrival
- 2. To self-isolate
- 3. To save and present your location data
- 4. To install contact apps (My SOS and COCOA)

[The Questionnaire]

Provide phone no., email address on questionnaire (for health check / follow-up by the authorities)

[Your Smartphone]

Either iPhone or Android; must be capable of downloading and running the required apps for contact-tracing, etc. during your quarantine period.

[The Apps]

- 1. MySOS: Video call app to confirm your location (daily) during quarantine
- 2. COCOA: contact-tracing app

IMPORTANT:

A visa alone will not be sufficient to qualify for re-entry. You will be required to present a negative COVID-19 test result from a test conducted within 72 hours of your flight's departure to the Quarantine Station.)

As you can see, much of the information is in Japanese, which at a glance may seem confusing or overly complicated, but MOFA has also provided information in English.

We understand that this is a lot to process, but it is extremely crucial that you read through all of this information.

Please remember that being vaccinated will NOT exempt you from having to submit your negative test results, or to undergo self-quarantine.

- Update your smartphone's OS if necessary (must be able to install the abovementioned apps)

To save time, it is recommended that you download the two apps (MySOS and COCOA) from the provided QR codes before boarding your flight, as the airport Wi-Fi in the terminal can get congested if everyone is downloading at the same time upon arrival.

-Please refrain from opening them before arriving in Japan, however.

-Please also check to see what version your smartphone's OS is on ahead of time.

iPhones must be on iOS 13.5 or higher, while Android phones must be on Android 6.0 or higher.
